

# **Guidelines for Public Access to the Taoyuan Campus of National Taipei University of Business**

- I. These Guidelines are formulated to maintain campus safety, effectively manage public access to the campus, and enhance the environmental quality of the campus.
- II. Outdoor areas open to the public: the sports field, outdoor courts, and the campus perimeter roads.  
Open hours: 6:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m., except during class hours on Sundays.
- III. Indoor areas open to the public: the Gong-Neng Building Library, and the outsourced dining services in the NTUB Dormitory.  
Open hours:
  1. Library: Monday to Friday, 8:30 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.; open during certain hours on holidays.
  2. Outsourced dining service shops: 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.
  3. Access shall be subject to the Library's actual opening and closing hours and the outsourced dining shops' actual business hours.
- IV. Matters to be observed:
  1. When the University holds major events or examinations, students shall comply with the University's control measures, and the campus may not be open to the public.
  2. Those entering the campus during non-access hours or accessing closed-off areas may be warned, ordered to leave, or reported to the police for handling in accordance with the law.
  3. Vehicles entering the campus shall comply with the University's "Guidelines for the Management of Automobiles and Motorcycles".
  4. Dangerous wildlife such as snakes, red imported fire ants, and hornets may be present on campus. Please pay attention to personal safety; all related responsibilities shall be borne by the entrant.
  5. If bringing pets, please be sure to keep them on a leash at all times, and promptly clean up after them.
  6. Smoking, drinking alcohol, and chewing betel nut are prohibited on campus.
  7. Barbecuing and the setting off of firecrackers, fireworks, sky rockets, and other combustible items are prohibited on campus.
  8. Commercial activities, gambling, and other improper conduct are prohibited on campus.
  9. Climbing on detention basins, the heart-shaped landscape pond, or hanging on basketball rims, goal frames, and other dangerous behaviors are prohibited.
  10. Littering and bringing household waste onto campus are prohibited.
  11. Please help maintain campus cleanliness and conserve water and electricity.
  12. Any person causing damage to the University's public property and facilities or trespassing shall be prosecuted in accordance with the law.
