

Dormitory Fee Standards, Taoyuan Campus of National Taipei University of Business

Approved by the 6th Administrative Meeting of the 2nd Semester of Academic Year 2013 in April 2014
Approved by the 1st Administrative Meeting of the 1st Semester of Academic Year 2016 in August 2016

- I. Water and electricity charges are already included as part of a student's dormitory fees. Air-conditioning is charged separately to residents using prepaid cards
- II. The double room (accessible) is limited to students with disabilities.
- III. Summer vacation fee standard: one-semester fee \times 11/18 (rounded up to the nearest hundred with no exceptions).
- IV. Winter vacation fee standard: one-semester fee \times 4/18 (rounded up to the nearest hundred with no exceptions).
- V. For short-term stays by off-campus persons, charges shall be calculated on the basis of one room for four persons, with a management fee of NT\$1,200 per room per day. If the number of occupants is less than the room's maximum occupancy, it shall still be charged as one room. The same applies to persons with disabilities staying in a double room. The fee includes water and electricity charges (air-conditioning requires purchase of prepaid cards)
- VI. The fee schedule is as follows:

Notes:

1. The 7th-floor quadruple rooms do not have heaters and are subject to a different rate than other floors (NT\$500 less per person per semester; during the winter vacation, the reduction shall be prorated accordingly).
2. The summer and winter vacation fee standards apply to University students only.
3. If University students need to stay during winter or summer vacation, please proceed in accordance with the Dormitory Residence Guidance and Management Regulations. The fee shall be calculated by multiplying the summer/winter vacation fee standard by the proportion of actual weeks of stay. If the stay is two weeks (inclusive) or less, the fee standard shall be calculated in accordance with the short-term stay fee. No refunds shall be granted for those moving out early.
4. Bed allocation during the summer and winter vacations shall be solely handled by the dormitory management staff of the University, and no objections shall be raised.
